Planting

- pollinating plants/fruit trees
- community garden
- incorporate recycled products into hard landscaping/paths etc.
- willing to help with gardening if needed (Jane Moreton)
- hops might do better than vines, bat/bird boxes, hazel, rowan, crab apple, song season of nectar/pollen flowers, non toxic

For Children

- small games area for under 8s
- concerned about installing, insuring maintenance, repair
- old tractor
- den building possibilities, willow tunnel
- seating/benches
- rocks/trees to climb, natural play rather than plastic ones, e.g. rope swing from tree
- interactive ? based on local plants/biodiversity etc.
- sundial
- benches
- unstructured space for maximum flexibility/minimum upkeep/minimum vandalism target
- pottery studio with lessons/workshop, canoe rental
- minimum impact, chipped bark not rubber surface
- willow boat for children
- den building materials
- children's garden, mint marigolds lavender

Anything Else

- open air theatre/concert space
- music/performance space
- Do it Yourself Workshop to hire to locals
- benches
- tree of life, totem?
- big mosaic

- benches or logs or any other kind of seating!
- Take entire towpath wall down, community farming plot area (wildflower plants like strawberries, blackberries)
- keep it natural, have get togethers like bonfire night with music and baked potatoes, community events with folk music, story telling etc.
- I don't approve of prettyfying a lovely self-naturalising area. There is a part of the tow-path wall that is tumbled down - why lower a beautiful wall? Where are the junkies+alkies supposed to go? What about the owls that already use these trees? I think this is awful. Why should people have access to everything?

- get stone wall person to teach others on our wall, industrial history of site to be recognised?-- old boat!
- I have seen a Daubaton bat on the bridge next to this land. I don't want any of the buildings demolished; safer for children if no gate on canal opening
- No gate on Aldcliffe Road because of traffic
- Paddling pool for summer (children size), viewing point for canal, shelter/benches
- local people could demolish building and sell slate on a voluntary basis. (I would be happy once insurance is sorted out)
- use small wood waste to make charcoal - I can do this (Duncan Bell)
- possibly a play area (with swing and maybe landscape slide for little children, benches
- Queries over keeping it nice (discuss drug use/dog mess/vandalism); compost/water collection - underground water tank may be more secure; roadside wall needs to be taller (railings?) if people are letting children run around here; ROAD CROSSING(maybe convex mirror, road crossing on apex of blind bend so you can see both ways around the bend?)
- If you require a wooden gate strong frame with ??? I will make it (Brian Hodgson)
- Improve safety of crossing Aldcliffe Rd. from Lower Regent Street
- benches for sitting
- benches/tables, some at child height; re drug users/needles - consult with drug+alcohol team
- notice board
