Dear Resident,

Further to our previous letters about the derelict land between Aldcliffe Rd and the canal towpath, we are pleased to report that we have now established agreement in principle from Lancaster City Council Property Services and British Waterways for our plans to improve the site.

City Council planners have confirmed that they consider the site to be suitable for use as green space, and the Conservation Officer is also happy with our proposals. The land is not considered suitable for other types of development such as housing or car parking due to the poor vehicular access.

It is now time to be constituting a formal organisation to take this forward, and to this end we are holding a public meeting on Monday 18th June at 7.30pm in Room 1 of the Friends Meeting House, which is on Meeting House Lane next to Lancaster train station.
